

Dear PSL and SIA Community,

As we prepare to return to campus for the Fall 2022 semester, if you haven't already, please take a moment to review this [PSU news article](#) for information related to COVID-19 for the University Park campus, including the Katz Building and the Clinics.

A couple of highlights from the article:

- Masking is not required in University Park campus buildings, except health care facilities. Employees at Penn State who work in their own individual offices may request that individuals wear masks while in their private offices, and faculty may request that their students wear masks during classes. The University asks that community members cooperate respectfully with these requests.
- Students should take a COVID-19 test before returning to campus using a rapid home test. If they test positive, they should stay home for at least five more days and test negative before coming to a campus.
- The University encourages all members of the community to stay up to date with their COVID-19 vaccinations — including booster doses — and to share their vaccination status with the University.
- If you're experiencing symptoms of COVID-19 or think you may have been exposed, please do not come to the building. Seek testing and contact your professors or supervisors, as appropriate.
