

DACA RESCISSION 2017:

WHAT WE KNOW

PERMIT STATUS

NEW APPLICATIONS:

NO LONGER ACCEPTED.

NEW APPLICATIONS OR RENEWALS THAT ARE PENDING:

APPLICATIONS WILL BE ADJUDICATED ON A CASE-BY-CASE BASIS.

PERMITS EXPIRING SEPTEMBER 5, 2017 - MARCH 5, 2018:

APPLICATIONS FOR RENEWAL WILL BE ADJUDICATED, IF ACCEPTED ON OR BEFORE OCTOBER 5, 2017.

PERMITS THAT EXPIRE AFTER MARCH 5, 2018:

APPLICATIONS FOR RENEWAL WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.

KEEP IN MIND:

- 1. ADVANCE PAROLE:** Applications for advance parole are no longer accepted. If you have advance parole, you retain the ability to travel, but Customs Border Protection (CBP) and United States Citizenship and Immigration Services (USCIS) have the discretion to make different decisions.
- 2. FRAUD:** Beware of individuals who present themselves as attorneys or who seek to take advantage of DACA recipients.
- 3. KNOW YOUR RIGHTS:** *Everyone* residing in the United States has rights. pennstatelaw.psu.edu/sites/default/files/KYRStateCollegeSeptember2017.pdf
- 4. OTHER OPTIONS:** You might be entitled to other immigration relief besides DACA. Seek legal counsel to discuss your options.
