WHAT WE KNOW

NEVER HAD DACA:

ELIGIBLE TO FILE
AN INITIAL
DACA REQUEST

KEEP IN MIND:

- FRAUD:** Beware of individuals who present themselves as attorneys or who seek to take advantage of DACA recipients.
- KNOW YOUR RIGHTS:** Everyone residing in the United States has rights. https://pennstatelaw.psu.edu/Learn_know_Rights
- OTHER OPTIONS:** Those who have never had DACA as well as those who have had DACA may be eligible for other immigration relief. Seek legal counsel to discuss your options.
- FILING FEE:** DACA application fees are \$495.00.
